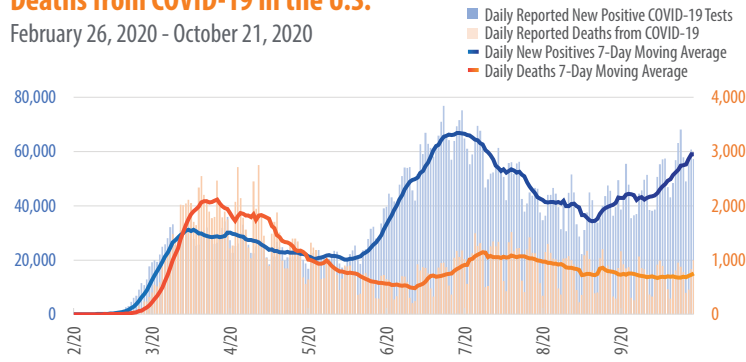

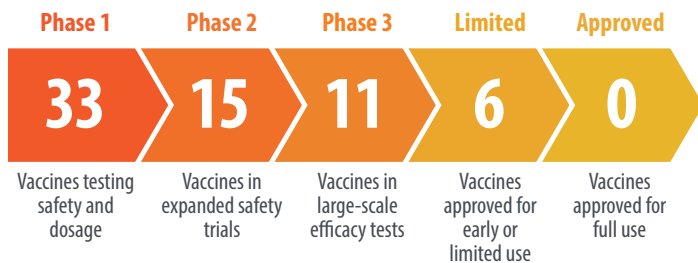

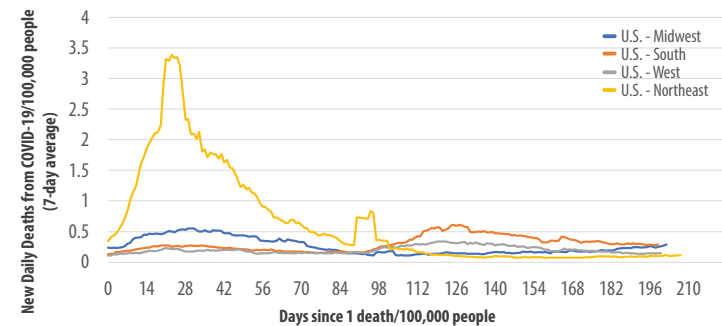

Daily Reported Deaths from COVID-19 per 100,000 People by U.S. Region

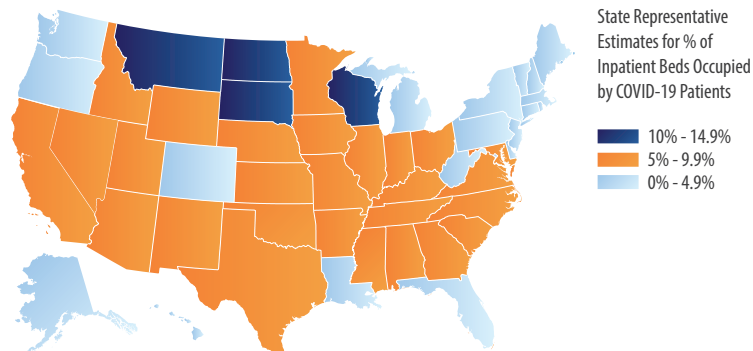

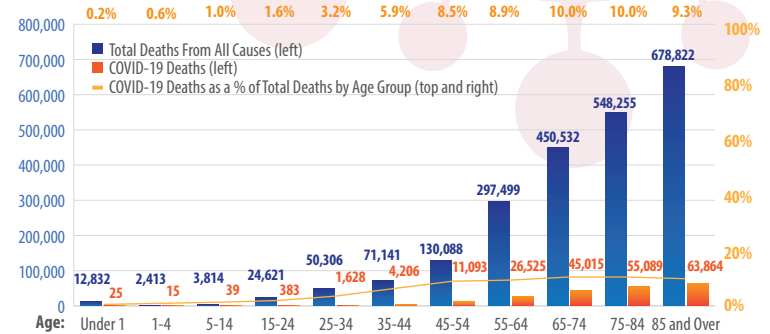

Total Deaths and COVID-19 Deaths in the U.S. by Age Group

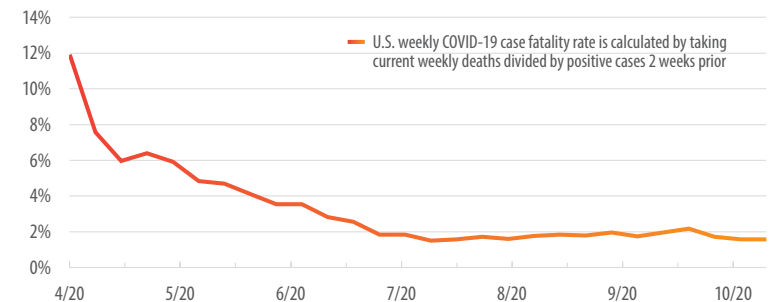

April 12, 2020 - October 18, 2020



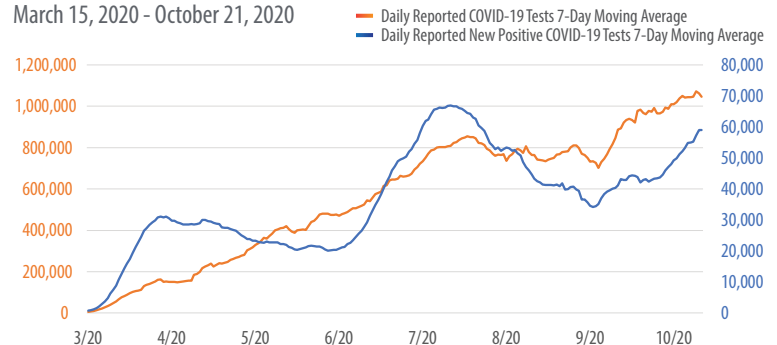

On October 21, **95 COVID-19 fatalities were reported in Florida**, 16 had at least a two-month separation between the time the individuals tested positive and passed away, another 5 had at least a three-month separation. Meanwhile 11 of the fatalities reported on October 21, occurred more than a month ago.²
