



February 26, 2020 - December 28, 2020





### **U.S. Weekly COVID-19 Case Fatality Rate**



# A study of nearly 10 million individuals in Wuhan, China between May 14 and June 1, 2020 found only 300 asymptomatic positive cases of COVID-19. A total of 1,174 close contacts of these asymptomatic carriers were also tested and all came back negative for the virus.1

### Total Deaths and COVID-19 Deaths in the U.S. by Age Group


